## IMPORTANT MEMBERS' UPDATE

### G.C.C.T.C.'S LIMITED OPENING JUNE 13/14 2020

The State Premier announced on May 31<sup>st</sup> that Queensland would move into Stage 2 of Covid-19 Restrictions effective midday June 1<sup>st</sup>. While our club is very keen to resume operations we need to have all of the compliance measures in place to meet legislative and insurance requirements, as well as our commitment to the safety of all our members and volunteers. We have been advised that we can look forward to compliance visits to ensure all requirements are met and we will ensure all is in order.

The following information is provided and is current at 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020. Any changes will be sent to members via these emailed updates and via Facebook posts. **This information applies to G.C.C.T.C. Members only at this time.**

The club has implemented an online booking system for booking practice sessions. You cannot just show up at the club, you must book a session in advance to attend. The booking URL is

To provide equitable opportunity for all members to book, the system will not be open for bookings until 6pm on Wednesday June 10. It will close midnight the day prior to the session being booked. If you know a member who wants to shoot and is not computer literate, please offer to help them make a booking yourself. Alternatively, they can call Shane Weeden on 0499103458 and ask for help to make a booking. Shane will not be using early access to the system and will be governed by the same start time as everyone else, so if you think that calling will definitely get you in, think again! You will compulsorily need to provide: ACTA Membership Number, Name, Full Residential Address, Contact Phone, and email address. These are mandatory requirements related to Covid-19 case tracking. If you are assisting someone else, have all that data ready before you start trying to book or calling Shane.

Our first days of planned operation are June 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>. Each day there will be 3 practice sessions: 10:00am-11:30am, 12:00pm-1:30pm and 2pm-3:30pm, with 15 positions available for booking in each session. Show up at the gate no earlier than 20 minutes prior to your session. Plan to leave as soon as your session is over. More details and requirements about club operation and what to expect will be included in an automatic email sent out when you book.

That said, there are some important guidelines we want to share up front:

- Our club recommends that members use the CovidSafe App and register before attending the club.
- Government recommendations are people aged 70 years and over, people aged 65 years and over with chronic medical conditions, people with compromised immune systems, and aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 50 years and over, are strongly

urged to stay at home for their own protection, and take extra precautions to reduce the risk of illness from COVID-19 and avoiding situations where you may come into contact with a lot of people.

- Consistent with widely advertised precautions, if you are unwell, or have had any cold or flu-like symptoms within the last 14 days, please DO NOT attend the club.
- Please only make one booking per weekend at this stage to give all members a chance to have a go. This is an honour system, though we will be checking for and strongly discouraging duplicates.
- Only GCCTC club members with an ACTA membership number may book and attend.
- Juniors must be accompanied by an adult, and not require coaching (i.e. be competent enough to shoot without a coach next to them). Both the junior and accompanying adult must have a booking in the same session. If the adult is not an ACTA member, use 000000 for ACTA membership number in booking tool.
- Trap/skeet only at this stage. Other disciplines when stage 3 restrictions come in. Committee members have been very vocal in advocacy for Sporting and Trench members.
- After the first weekend of June 13/14, we are planning to open on Friday/Saturday only of subsequent weeks at least while we are under stage 2 restrictions.
- Rounds and enviro levy will be the usual costs for members and juniors. We anticipate you will have time for at least two rounds, maybe three depending on the readiness and efficiency of your particular session participants. We will learn what works and iterate after the first weekend. Payment must be by EFTPOS, preferably tap 'n go. No cash can be accepted at this time.
- No food or drinks are available. BYO requirements.
- Ammunition will be available from the club.
- Members cannot share or borrow equipment - you have to bring and use your own.

Many hours from volunteers have been put into this arrangement for the benefit of our members. Non-compliance with Government Regulations or the directions of our volunteers puts the entire shooting community's return to operations at risk. We will be under scrutiny and we cannot afford mistakes.
