



MEMBERS' UPDATE FOR PRACTICE SESSIONS **FRIDAY 26 and SATURDAY 27 JUNE**

Please be aware that this URL is different from last week, and will change each week.

Friday 26 June. One session 10am - 2pm. 9 skeet, 18 trap spots available.

Saturday 27 June. Two sessions. Morning session 9:30am - 12noon. Afternoon session 1pm - 3.30pm. Each session will have 9 skeet, 9 sporting and 18 trap spots available.

As you may have noticed above, this week the committee is pleased to announce the return of sporting clays to Saturday practice!

This is possible as the club is moving to an operational model which permits an increase in total concurrent numbers on the club grounds, however this model also comes with some particular new rules:

- You will notice when booking this week that you **must** choose both a practice time slot, AND a discipline (trap, skeet, sporting). The major difference to shooters will be that when assigned to a discipline and subsequent squad/layout, you must only practice with the group of people you have been assigned to. You may not break away from that group of people and go shoot with another group during your session. Your Trap Official and/or Range Officer can provide any clarification or guidance on the day if you have questions about this requirement. Please follow their instructions as normal.

Because of the change in total on-premises numbers we are decreasing the number of sessions but increasing their length, this is to allow shooters to not feel rushed. You may also find that you have to wait for another squad using your layout between shooting rounds (at maximum capacity, there can be 10 people in a group allocated to a layout including officials). When this happens and it is not your turn to shoot, please either wait in your car, or bring your own chair. Remember, it remains important to observe personal hygiene and social distancing requirements at all times.

On booking, you will receive a follow up email. It's important to read this email, even if you've booked in previous weeks, as the contents (i.e. the conditions and operating processes) do change.

Bookings this week are open to all ACTA members, and the TryBooking service will open **Wednesday 24 June 6pm as usual**. Closes midnight day before respective sessions.

The club is always looking for extra volunteers for the practice roster to help spread the load amongst the membership. If you feel you can contribute the occasional day back to the club, please call Brad Park on 0432040927 to be added to the volunteers list.
